Stay in left lane follow signs toward Gurley St.

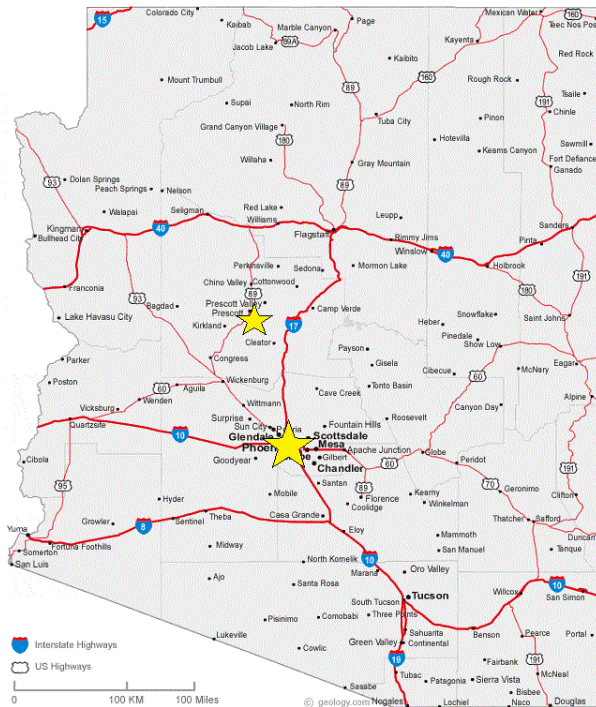
Turn left onto S Montezuma St (Whiskey Row)

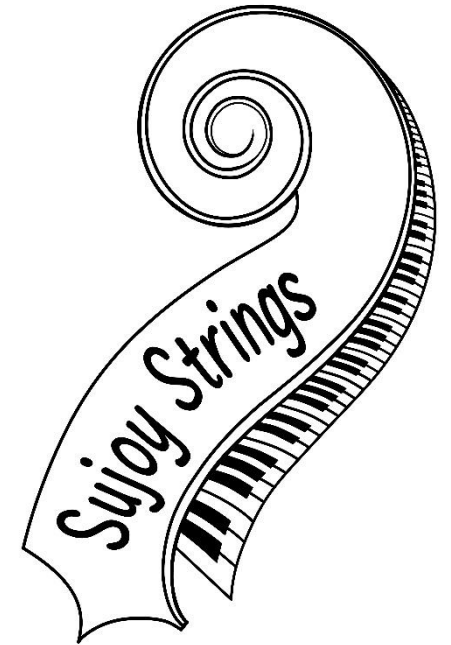
